

Music at St Joseph's School

Music plays an important part in the life of St Joseph's and is taught to all pupils throughout the school from the Nursery to Year 11. Music appears additionally as an option at GCSE level in Years 10 and 11. Over the past six years, 88% of candidates have achieved A*/A grades.

Extra-curricular work forms a major part of music making within the school and is a valuable means of extending the musical experience of the pupils. Any pupils, whether receiving lessons at school or privately, is eligible to attend an ensemble when they reach a suitable level of competence. Details of these activities can be found in a separate leaflet.

Specialist Scholarships

Examination date: 15th January 2011

Scholarships valued at £750 plus free tuition in one instrument.

Requirements: 11+ **Approximately Grade 4+ Standard**
13+ **Approximately Grade 6 Standard**

General musicianship and potential are very important and play a large part in the overall assessment of the candidate.

Evidence of examination passes is helpful. Please bring a portfolio containing copies of examination certificates/mark sheets, festival adjudication sheets and any other relevant material to support the application,

A willingness to participate enthusiastically in school ensembles and choirs is essential.

Audition: Two contrasting pieces on first study, one piece on second study (if applicable), sight-reading, aural tests and informal interview with the Director of Music.
